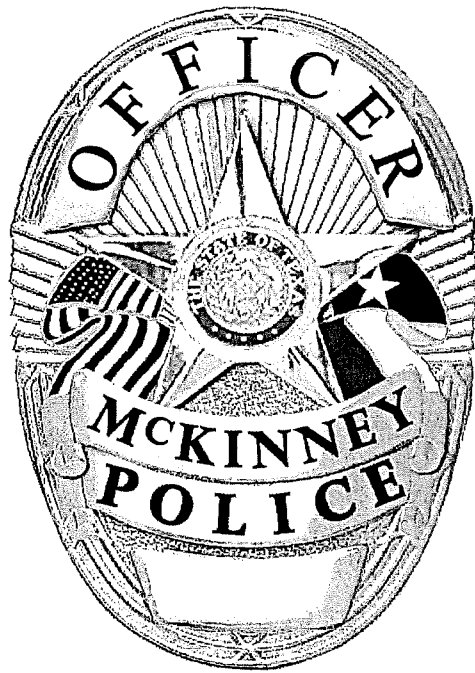

SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

The McKinney Police Department is affording young people of our community the opportunity to experience law enforcement first hand. The **McKinney Police Department Teen Police Academy** will hold three (3) camps in the summer of **2017**. The first two camps will be a basic entry level academy. The last camp will require completion of the 2015, 2016 or 2017 basic level academy and will be a four day advance level academy.

The academy will be similar in nature to those actual police cadets attend. Students will learn the basic functions of a working police department as well as have a chance to explore the idea of a possible career in this ever changing and demanding field. Students will attend regular classes with topics including, but not limited to, Texas law, patrol procedures, traffic enforcement, and many other areas of law enforcement. Students will have the opportunity to practice what they learn in practical exercises. **The basic academy will be one (1) week long and will be Monday thru Friday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. The advance academy will be four (4) days long and will be Monday thru Thursday 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.** Students will have several breaks throughout the day as needed.

This application will include a background check, medical and parental release forms. **The academy will consist of students who reside in the city of McKinney and who will be in the 7th, 8th or 9th grade.** Students will be expected to take the program seriously, and follow academy rules, which closely resemble school rules. **Due to the seriousness of the content of this program, immature behavior will not be tolerated.** Students will be chosen in the order that all paperwork is received and upon successful completion of the background check.
