The purpose of today's letter is to remind you that the May STAAR scores are now available in the Home Access Center (HAC). To see your child's test scores, log into HAC, then click on Grades>Test Scores, then scroll down to find the STAAR test from this past school year's grade level and over to the far right you'll see a **"Student Portal Unique Access Code"**. Once you have the unique code, visit <http://www.texasassessment.com/students> and enter the unique access code from HAC and your child's birthday.

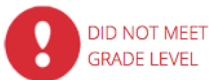

You will then see all of your child's scores going all the way back to the first STAAR test taken. By the way, the state has changed the labels used for STAAR this year. The old *"Level I: Unsatisfactory"*, *"Level II: Satisfactory"* and *"Level III: Advanced"* labels have been replaced with four new labels *"Did Not Meet"*, *"Approaches Grade Level"*, *"Meets Grade Level"*, and *"Masters Grade Level"* labels.
