## MS Football

  - MISD Stadium & Ron Poe Stadium – total of 1000 tickets for home and 1000 for visitor for middle school parents and general public. Both home and visitor sides will be open, with only the home side gate open for entry
  - McKinney North Stadium – Total of 390 tickets for home and 390 for visitor for middle school parents and general public. Coaches will encourage parents when playing at McKinney North to stay for their student's game only, and then leave so we can maintain 50% capacity, plus social distancing.

## MS Volleyball
